Discussion on the minutes of last meeting. December 2nd and December 10th Trustee Fulmer made a motion to approve Minutes. **Trustee Millett** Seconded it. All in favor-Aye.

Paying of Bills: Trustee Fulmer made a motion to approve **Abstract #7. Trustee Caputo** seconded it. All in favor-Aye.

Zoning Report: Mr. Shimmel- “Pat Snyder will have a subdivision. ZBA is short a member. Couple of projects coming up. River Hospital is building a small addition on the down river end of the property. We have a site plan application for Mishar Holdings who shortened the dock up due to being turned down before. I handed out the current tall grass law. Back in October I gave you a summary of the violations. We have a policy of cutting the grass after 3 days. We may need a rate of some sort to make the owners comply. We came up with the figure of between \$300- \$400. We will hold a Public Hearing to change the law.

Trustee Reports:

Trustee Fulmer- “If anyone out there wants to be a lifeguard training begins February-March. We need 4-5 lifeguards for the season. Office is working well together.”

Trustee Strough- Nothing for me.

Trustee Caputo- “I have 1 application for the golf course turned in. 1 of the ladies that plays pickleball stopped by today and 2 of the nets they have are taped together. I would like to make a motion to buy 4 new Pickleball nets. Trustee Fulmer seconded. All in Favor-Aye.

Trustee Millett- “They are doing a 20 Year complete review on the sewer plant. Railings need to be fixed. We are waiting for a second quote for the muffin monster.

The water plant replaced some pumps and repaired the boiler. Everything is running satisfactory.”

Police Report: The police department had 5 complaints, 0 arrests, 0 tickets issued and 0 warning. Also 5 parking tickets were issued and 0 warnings. 2 Building checks.
