Public Comments / Concerns: None

Correspondence: Melissa at the golf course does an amazing job for the Alex Bay ladies Golf League. A huge thank you to her and the gentlemen that work in the course. The greens are beautiful.

Someone apologized that they ran out of quarters and got a courtesy envelope for parking meters. They thanked the Village for not giving them a ticket.

Discussion on the minutes of last meeting. June 10, 2025 Trustee Strough made a motion to approve Minutes. **Trustee Millett** Seconded it. All in favor-**Aye**.

Paying of Bills: Trustee Millett made a motion to approve **Abstract #1. Trustee Strough** seconded it. All in favor

Trustee Millett made a motion to hire David Farrell for club house and Lyla Nicholas for lifeguard. **Trustee Strough** seconded. All in favor- **Aye.**

Zoning Report: Mr. Shimel- “I’d like to thank the board for setting a public hearing to reduce the number of members for the ZBA. I had issued a stop work order for the photo booth down on James. No site plan and the operator has been approached a couple of times as I understand it. I guess we don’t know if the Stop work Order is effective or not, but it is posted on the outside of the little photo booth. They will need a site plan review because it is a business in the Village.”

DPW Report: Trustee Strough- “Jarrett’s been cleaning up all the brush. We had all them storms and spent a pile of time cleaning up brush. They’ve been cold patching the roads. Weve had a sewer break down on Walton St which they dug up and repaired. They’ve been out cold patching a lot of spots. I’ve gone down and checked them and they’re looking half way decent.”

Trustee Fulmer” Before we move on to Greg, is there a Hillary Wolfe here? You have correspondence about your water sewer bill?”

Hillary Wolfe-“Yeah so I had a pipe come unglued in my house over the winter. 147000 gallons of water. I would like to be able to pay this over a certain amount of time.”

Trustee Millett- “I did not get anything. Usually they put it I my box, unless they put it in today. I didn’t get up here today to check.”

Trustee Fulmer-“ I will do docks and lifeguard. We just hired our final lifeguard and we have 4 now working. The beach is scheduled 11am-7pm. The dock attendants, we have 4 of those. They seem to be doing very well. This past weekend was a busy weekend. We had a lot of people stay over. 4th of July was busy. I thought it was the busiest fourth of July since Covid.”

Police Report: Trustee Fulmer- “To the Village Board from Officer in Charge, Joshua David. The police department had 13 complaints, 0 arrests, 0 V&T tickets issued and 3 warnings. 200 parking tickets issued and 7 building checks. I would also like to remind the citizens that I can be reached at 315-418-0058 to discuss any concerns or questions that they may have.”

Project Reports: BCA- Gregor- “Couple of updates on the water project, the water storage tank and the electrical contract have been awarded. The requests for bonds were sent to the contractors. We have a meeting scheduled this Friday with the Office of Renewal at

3pm. We also have a meeting on Thursday at 4pm. Easements are probably the next big item to tackle. Last meeting we talked about possibly bidding the filters. There are 2 main manufacturers. Atlantic Testing has a few borings left on Church street to complete.”

Public Concerns: Doug Toulach-“Christmas in July Parade. All the ducks are in a row. July 26th at 8:30pm.”

Todd Sanford-“I’m going to put in a new sewer line. Mines been compromised. I will put in probably after Labor day. “

Erica Sanford-“Any more on the cameras in the Village?”

Trustee Fulmer-“Not yet. A law would have to be passed.”
