**Correspondence-Suzanne Fayette-** Would like the Village Board to “do their job” and enforce snow removal as she is an avid walker year-round. Board said they need to put an ordinance in and add higher fines. Trustee Caputo said we had a lot of damn snow this year.

**Minutes-** January 13, 2026- Special Meeting January 30, 2026 and February 10, 2026 **Trustee Fulmer** made a motion to accept the minutes. **Trustee Strough** Seconded. **All in Favor-Aye**

**Paying of Bills: Trustee Fulmer** made a motion to accept Abstract #9 of bills. **Trustee Millett** second. **All in Favor-Aye.**

**DPW Report- Jarrett** – Started Cold Patching yesterday then we got caught up in plugged sewers. We are still not picking up brush because the pit is still closed right now. Construction debris is not to be put out for garbage day. Center wall is out at the Old Chamber along with one of the concrete closets and all debris is removed. Next is the center support to be able to take the center concrete wall out. Sewer tractor trailer has a new radiator in it. Froze water lines in peoples house had to be taken care of. Gill is fixing the sign from a few years ago when a waste management truck hit the very bottom and creased it.

**Police Report: Marco Mancini-** “ February stats are 10 parking tickets, 4 complaints, 1 accident. Just a reminder, no matter what, call 911. Even if it turns out to be nothing. Scammers are calling people. Don't fall for it.

**Zoning Report: Lee-** Planning board is meeting tomorrow night to consider 2 sign applications on the end of James St. at Crossmon House. The Planning Board will probably be involved with 1864 restaurant and what's going on down there. Had a meeting with people from Department of State for Local Waterfront Revitalization Program(LWRP).

**Trustee Reports:**

**Trustee Millett-** Month of February the Water Plant is still satisfactory. They are installing new meters. They thawed 8 water lines. Had 2 main breaks. One on Holland St and one on Rock St. Rock St broke 3 times after they fixed it. Number 1 filter went down today. Gregor is going to talk to The Department of Health about one filter going down. Trustee Millett is giving DPW Supervisor Jarrett his full backing on the Trash issue. Trash cans need lids. Skunks are coming out. A van not from here tossed their trash out the back, into Goerger's trash that's not in a trash can. We are getting outside garbage.

**Trustee Fulmer-** "Have 1 lifeguard who defiantly wants to come back. Noah has another job, so he won't be returning. We are going to start putting ads in the paper for lifeguards and dock attendants.

**Trustee Fulmer** made a motion to approve a match of \$2500 so the Thousand Islands Divers Alliance can start the grant that they discussed last month. **Trustee Millett** Seconded. **All in favor-Aye.**

**Trustee Caputo-** Liquor license wasn't done. Board agreed to scrap it. This is the end of her term, and she didn't want her name on it. Went to a few houses the easements. Would like Trustee Millett to go with her. People are having issues with the way the easement is read.

**Project Reports: BCA- Gregor-** Submitted design documents to the Department of Health last week. It takes a couple of months for the review process. Progress meeting on 03/24 at 4pm and Easement review/signing at 5pm. Would like Pat and Kevin there for the progress meeting. Tank installer is beginning of May now. They had a couple of delays with other projects. Department of Transportation had a few minor adjustments and that has been sent back. Working with Taylor from DANC for the Community Development Block Grant. There is stuff that needs to be done before the bids. Big thing is easements need to be turned in to be able to start construction.

**Old Business- Trustee Fulmer** made a motion to accept the Procurement Policy. **Trustee Caputo** Seconded. **All in favor-Aye.**

**New Business-** Trustee Fulmer said we need to have a workshop for the Open Container Policy. Trustee Caputo said “our Local Law from 1993 says there’s no open containers in the bay unless it is a special event that is approved by the board.” Her opinion is there should be no change. We have no open containers. She also commented saying that part of everyone’s complaint was that we were hearing that everything was just kind of wild that we had no police presence. We didn’t have any enforcement. We didn’t have any of this. Well, we have enforcement now. We have a more engaged police force. Let them enforce our laws. If there’s a committee that has a special event that they want to sell beer on the sidewalk, if Cavallerio’s is requesting from the liquor authority a special event which they can as a liquor person they can do that 12 times a year. They’re supposed to get our permission. That’s part of the whole process through the liquor authority. Make them follow the rules. Marco said he could go to the businesses and talk to them one on one and explain to them.
